(Minimum composite score of 26 is required. Sub scores must be from the same test as the composite score submitted. If retaking the ACT, the new test scores are due by March 1, 2018)

FINANCIAL information: cost of college, your school budget, employment

Parents IRS 1040 for 2016. Deadline: January 15, 2018

Pages 1 & 2 only! Taxable Income information must not exceed \$120,000. Social security numbers may be blackened out.

Activities / Athletics / Honors: years of participation, officers and leadership roles

Short Essay: 200 words or less on Why do you think you should be selected for this scholarship?

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION *Students are responsible for contacting teachers or counselors to submit a letter on his/her behalf. Out of respect, **ask them early!** We recommend asking them before the Thanksgiving holiday. Two letters are required. At least **one letter must be from a math or science teacher.***
