We will communicate with applicants exclusively by email. Be sure to include an email address on your application that you will check frequently from November 1 – April 30.

APPLICATION

- Intended College(s) & Field(s) of Study**
- High School and College Credits**
- GPA (minimum 3.5)** **Number of Students in Senior Class**
- ACT Score** **Retaking the ACT** (must be done before March 1)
 (Minimum composite score of 26 is required. Sub scores must be from the same test as the composite score submitted. If retaking the ACT, the new test scores are due by March 1, 2017)
- FINANCIAL Information- cost of college, school budget, employment**
- Parents IRS 1040 for 2015 – Pages 1 & 2 only.** Taxable Income information must not exceed \$120,000. That number is found on line 43. Social security numbers must be blackened out.
- Form 4506-T – Request for Transcript of Tax Return Release Form. (Signed)**
- Activities / Athletics / Honors – years of participation, officers and leadership roles**
- Short Essay – *Why do you think you should be selected for this scholarship?* (250 words or less)**

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: *Students are responsible for contacting teachers or counselors to submit a letter on his/her behalf. Out of respect, ask them early! We recommend asking them before the Thanksgiving holiday. Two letters are required. At least one letter must be from a math or science teacher.*
